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International Symposium on Entrepreneurship and Career Services



Isra University, Hyderabad in collaboration with Ball State University, USA organized a two-day International Symposium on 'Higher Education Initiatives in Entrepreneurship and Career Services' on 27 & 28 July 2016 at Movenpick Hotel, Karachi.

The opening held on 27 July 2016 which was attended by well reputed personalities from academia, government and corporate sector. The program comprised keynote speeches, thematic panel sessions and group activities related to challenges of entrepreneurship and career services at universities in Pakistan.

In this program, which was funded by the U.S. Department of State participants from universities located in KPK, Sukkur, Gilgit Baltistan and Balochistan were present.

The initial part of the event on day 1 started with speeches including speech of Prof. Dr. Hameedullah Kazi Pro-Vice Chancellor, Engineering and Management Sciences, Isra University; Prof. Dr Ghulamqadir Kazi Vice Chancellor, Isra University; A. J. Jagelski, Cultural Attaché U.S. Consulate Karachi; Dr. Kenneth Holland and Dr Julie Barker from Ball State University, USA. The experts highlighted the significance and challenges of entrepreneurship in Pakistan and the panel discussions led to effective strategies to meet discussed challenges.


The latter part of the event included panel sessions that were headed by Dr. Javeid Iqbal, Vice Chancellor, University of Balochistan; Dr. Abdul Raheem, Vice Chancellor, University of Science and Technology Bannu; Dr. Muhammad Asif Khan, Vice Chancellor, Korakoram International University; Dr. Ghulamqadir Kazi, Vice Chancellor, Isra University; Dr. Hameedullah Kazi, Pro Vice Chancellor, Isra University; and Dr. Kenneth Holland, Director, Center for International Development, Ball State University, USA.

The experts highlighted core issues of entrepreneurship and career services and suggested that industry and academia should work together and communication should be enhanced between them. They expressed that entrepreneurial activities will help address the ground issues of communities, hence universities should develop curricula that can facilitate this process. Moreover, youth

especially girls should be encouraged to create innovation and adapt to face the challenges that are essential for a successful entrepreneur. They noted that friendly policies should be put in place that can make acquiring seed money easier, reduce business risk and fulfil training gaps. Dr. Qamaruddin Mahar, Chairperson of Management Sciences at Isra University concluded the session. The second day commenced with the keynote speeches of Dr Kenneth Holland and Julie Lebo who talked about empowering and facilitating women entrepreneurs and job seekers. During their speech they highlighted the role of women in the business community and expressed their preference for an active women representation in work place saying, "For a prosperous business community it's very important for men and women to contribute their efforts equally."

The second keynote speaker of the day, Mr Jim McAtee presented on 'Modern Trends in Career Services'. He stated the changing role of career services in the world. He shared the principles and procedures with which Ball State University has been successful in running its career center.

The symposium, graced with the presence of distinguished Vice Chancellors of various universities and experts from corporate sector, was very successful.



Course on Management of Weapon-Wounded Patients in Asia

A course on the management of 'Weapon-wounded patients in Asia', jointly organized by International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) and Isra University was for the first time held from 25th to 29th July at Isra University Islamabad Campus.

Pro-Vice Chancellor, Isra University Islamabad, Professor Dr. Umar Ali Khan presided over the closing ceremony with the chief guest, Mr. Reto Stocker, Head of Delegation, International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC). This 5-day certificate course was CME accredited. Renowned Surgeons of ICRC, Dr. Asa Moldah (Sweden) and Dr Morco Pinter (Italy), conducted the course with the help of faculty members of surgery department of Isra University Islamabad including Prof. Dr. Ishtiaq Ahmed, Head of Surgery Department; Dr. Salman Tipu, Associate Professor and Vice Dean Clinical Sciences; and Dr. Junaid Javed. A diverse group of 30 surgeons from all over the country attended the course.

The purpose of the training was to promote a surgical module with an objective of improving the knowledge and skills of the surgeons on the comprehensive clinical management of patients injured by explosive weapons with a focus on surgical techniques, related procedures and protocols. Also, the course intended to prepare the health-care professionals to deal with weapon-wounded patients in a limited-resource scenario.

While addressing the participants, Dr. Asa Moldah (Sweden), International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) said that the ICRC has worked in different parts of the world. During these years, the ICRC has developed expertise in different fields of humanitarian services. She added that surgeons showed a great interest and appreciated the initiative, which would guide them to deal with weapons-wounded patients while enhancing their knowledge and skills. She termed it as the right step towards more integrated assessment. She advised the participants to familiarize themselves with some critical challenges being faced by Pakistan. The event reaffirmed her strong belief that a right step had been taken by the participants with a deepening commitment to help improve the lives of the people, who needed their assistance the most. Such ventures go a long way in helping the marginalized communities. "Healing is a matter of time, but it is sometimes also a matter of opportunity", she continued. ICRC transfers its capabilities to the local communities by engaging with the local

institutions.

Course coordinator Dr. Salman Ahmed Tipu presented a vote of thanks to all the participants of the course who had travelled long distances from all over the country to attend the course.

Mr. Reto Stocker praised the efforts of Isra University in the field of Health Services and said that it was an honour for the ICRC to work with such a reputed institute. He explained that the ICRC was an impartial, neutral and an independent organization whose exclusive humanitarian mission was to protect the lives and dignity of victims of armed conflict and other situations of violence, and to provide them with assistance. He said that the institutions and people of Pakistan show incredible zeal when it comes to their commitment towards philanthropy.

In the closing ceremony, Pro-Vice Chancellor, Isra University Islamabad, Professor Dr. Umar Ali Khan while speaking on the occasion, briefly explained about the establishment of Isra University and Al-Nafees Medical College Hospital, a feather in the cap of Isra Islamic Foundation. He said that the Foundation was treading on the right path by not only working in the field of education but also by meeting the challenges on the health and welfare fronts. He thanked the guests and participants for sparing their precious time out of their busy schedules.

In the end, Professor Dr. Umar Ali Khan presented souvenir to the Chief Guest and awarded certificates to the participants.

number of fatal diseases emerging in the society. ANMC&H has also been included in this list. ANMC&H now enjoys legal authority to provide safe blood and blood products to the patients. ANMC&H has also established a student based society to donate blood to the needy, impoverished patients in case of emergency.

As a follow-up to the linkages, Isra University has scheduled to




conduct various workshops for students at its partnering institutions on how to launch their own business and how to conduct an effective job search.

Gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD) is a chronic digestive disease. GERD occurs when stomach acid or, occasionally, stomach content, flows back into your food pipe (oesophagus). The backwash (reflux) irritates the lining of your oesophagus and causes GERD. Its Management is highly recommended by professionals to avoid complications in digestion. Prof. Sadik Memon along with post graduate students from AIMS attended and presented his talk on recent advances in the Management of GERD. The overview of GERD was presented by

Prof. Abdul Sattar Memon followed by case presentations by Dr. Javeria Memon and Dr. Salma Rabail. Prof. Waseem Memon discussed the etiopathogenesis of GERD, while Dr Javeria Farid presented the clinical features and differential diagnosis of the same. Dr. Shaista and Dr. Techand Meshwari highlighted the investigation procedure and complications respectively. The medical, surgical and endoscopic treatment of GERD were elaborated by Dr. Shabana, Dr Abdul Sattar Memon and Dr. Amir Ghorri respectively.

Program concluded with question and answer session and certificate distribution by Prof. M. H. Laghari, after which lunch was served.

In correlation with those instructive strategies, the teachers own philosophical beliefs of instruction are harboured and governed by the pupil's background knowledge and experience, situation, and environment, as well as learning goals set by the student and teacher. One example would be the Socratic schools of thought.

The training was attended by a good number of teachers from Isra University as well as teachers from the region of Sindh. Participants belonged to Nawabshah, Mirpurkhas and Hyderabad. 
