Dean Faculty of Basic Medical Sciences

- University is functional from 31st August and students and on campus classes will also start from 15th September 2020 hence following SOPs be implemented to prevent and trace the COVID 19 spread in the premises and making Isra University Hospital and its paraphernalia safe.

SOPS

1. Classes be held in well ventilated hall with chairs/desk placed at 2-meter distance horizontally and vertically (Responsible person: Deans/ O&M Department)

- 2. Students and faculty must wear mask of standard material and medical grade fabrics/N.95/K 95(Responsible Person: Deans and

- 3. Hand be sanitized with standard sanitizer or washed with soap and water while entering the classes and leaving the class (Deans/Vice Dean/Focal Person COVID 19) Year Coordinator)

- 4. Class should not be of more than 20 students (Responsible Person: Deans/Vice Dean/Students Chief Coordinator/Year Coordinator)

- 5. Public transport Vans and Buses transporting students or faculty staff all kind be sanitized during pic and drop use with safe and 5% chlorinated solution /or any safe detergent including diluted Dettol and masks to all users including driver conductor is mandatory (Responsible Person: Transport officer and Security Officer)

- 6. Temperature and Oximetry check be done at opening time and closing time of all students. faculty. and staff (HODS/ Year Coordinators and Focal Persons Desk in charges)

- 7. Any high grade fever, respiratory symptoms found be isolated for which four beds two for males and two for females in safe and near to hospital be arranged with notice of COVID Isolation (Dean Clinical and Hospital Director/ chairperson Medicine Department)

- 8. Two senior Physician and one nurse and paramedic be notified to evaluated suspected COVID cases (PVC Medical and Dean Clinical and Hospital Director)

- 9. SOPs posters be printed and pasted in all teaching halls/classes and main entrance of Hospital and all other blocs and departments notice boards (Director Students Affairs and Manager Hospital Marketing)
