

AWARENESS WALK ON "YOUM-E-ISTEHSAL FOR SOLIDARITY WITH KASHMIRIS"

n Monday, Isra University held a significant Awareness Walk titled "Youm-e-Istehsal for Solidarity with Kashmiris." This event aimed to draw attention to the ongoing struggles of the Kashmiri people under what is



perceived as illegal occupation and to mark the controversial actions of the Indian government on August 5, 2019, when Article 370 of the Indian Constitution, which had granted special autonomy to Jammu and Kashmir, was abrogated.

The walk commenced at Academic Block-A and concluded at Academic Block-E, symbolizing a unified stance in support of the Kashmiri cause. The event began with the recitation from the Holy Quran, followed by the playing of the national anthems of Pakistan and Kashmir, which invigorated the participants. Dr. Ahmed Waliullah Kazi, Vice Chancellor, Isra University, delivered a compelling and impassioned address, emphasizing the day's significance and reiterating the university's commitment to raising awareness about the Kashmiri issue.



In his speech, Dr. Kazi discussed how, on August 5, 2019, the Indian government revoked the special status of Jammu and Kashmir, which had allowed the region its own constitution, flag, and autonomy over internal matters, with the exception of defense, communications, and foreign affairs. He also addressed the subsequent bifurcation of the state into two Union Territories—Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh—under direct governance from New Delhi. Dr. Kazi highlighted the extensive reactions to this move, both within India and globally, describing it as a pivotal moment that significantly altered the



region's relationship with India and its geopolitical dynamics.

The walk witnessed active participation from the university's leadership, faculty, staff, and students. Notable participants included Dr. Ahmed Waliullah Kazi, Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Hameedullah Kazi, Director, Isra Islamic Foundation and Former Chancellor, Mr. Ghulam Rasool Kazi, Registrar & Director of Finance, and Deans Prof. Dr. Suhail Kazi, Prof. Dr. Khalid Talpur, Prof. Dr. Asad Jaskani, and Prof. Dr. Salman Shafiq. 
SPOTE LAUNCHES FIRST GERMAN LANGUAGE COURSE AT ISRA UNIVERSITY

Cash prizes were awarded to the top three models and posters by the Vice Chancellor of Isra University, celebrating the exceptional talent and creativity of the participating students.






ORIENTATION SESSION FOR NEW INCUBATES AT ISRA UNIVERSITY'S BUSINESS INCUBATION CENTER







ENGAGING ONLINE SESSION ON ISLAMIC FINANCE ORGANIZED BY SPOTE
